## Ron Bandy Driver Training

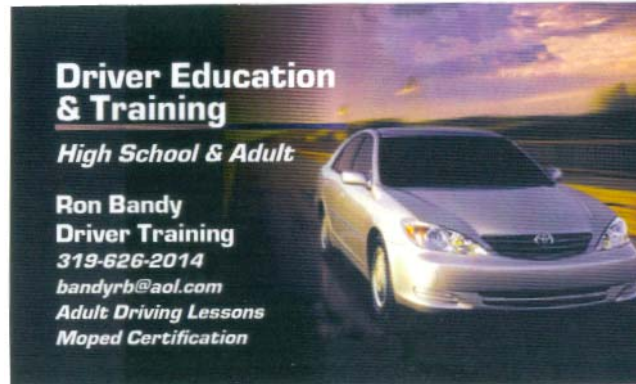
**Motorcycle Classes:** Please call for schedule, fees and information.
